 responsible for any loss or damage to the Equipment.
- 3. All personnel working in the Department of Agricultural, Food and Nutritional Science are required to complete health and safety orientation and training including, WHMIS, Laboratory Safety, Chemical Safety and/or Concepts in Biosafety provided by the University of Alberta, prior to commencement of the project. Additional job specific training may be required.
- 4. Access to the laboratory is limited to the regular business hours of 8am to 4pm, Monday to Friday. The instrument may run outside of these hours.
- 5. The Customer will be responsible to provide their consumables. The Customer is expected to remove any solvent or chemical waste, produced during their use of the instrument. Failure to do so will result in additional Waste Disposal charges.

- 6. In the event of damage to, or loss of any component of the Equipment, the Customer shall pay the total of all unpaid rent payments for the entire Agreement term plus full compensation for replacement for replacement and/or repair.
- 7. The Customer shall not remove or modify the equipment or any of its components from its current location and setup.
